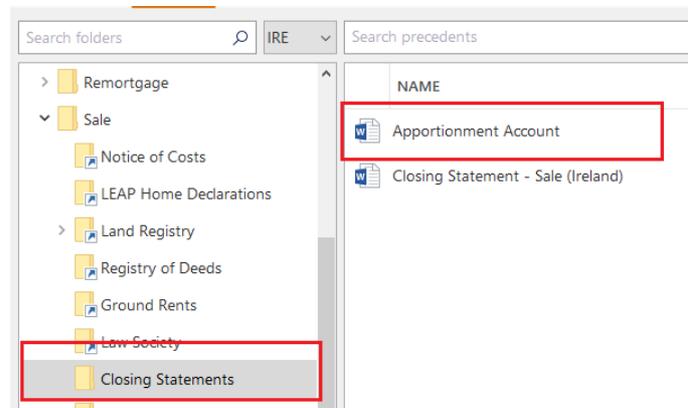

Any rows on the Apportionment tab that are not completed, will not appear in the generated document.

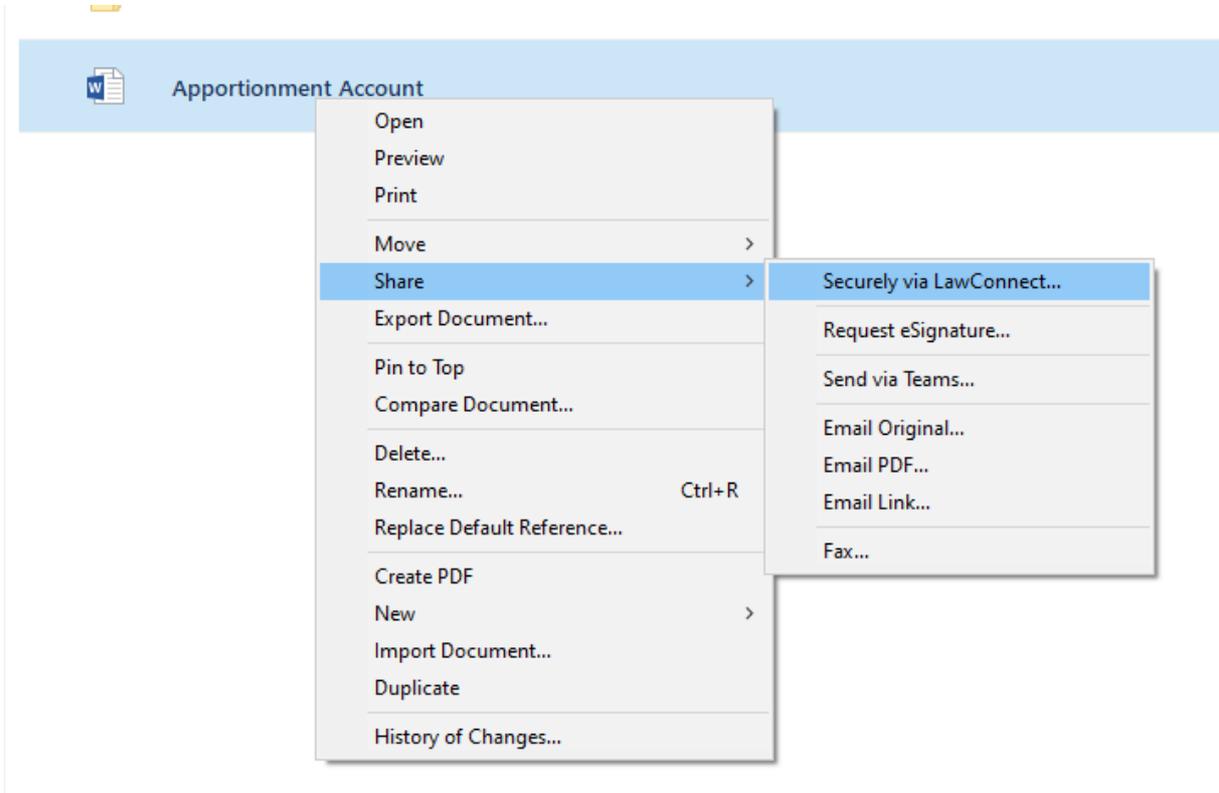
To amend or delete any values, go back to the Apportionment tab, and make your changes. You can then update the document by using the 'Update' button in the LEAP Ribbon.
